A small work does not necessarily offer a smaller experience

Vivienne Roberts Projects presents *A Winter's Tale*, an exhibition of small-scale works by 49 artists, bringing together painting, drawing, printmaking, collage, sculpture and mixed media.

At a time when images are so often encountered at speed and at a distance, these works ask us to come closer. Their intimate scale concentrates the gaze, allowing details, gestures and shifts of colour to become newly perceptible. A small work does not necessarily offer a smaller experience; its physical dimensions can instead create a more sustained and intimate encounter.

The title is taken from Shakespeare's *The Winter's Tale*, a play concerned with time, loss, transformation, revelation and the unexpected. It provides a loose frame for an exhibition in which contemplation and humour, silence and surprise can exist alongside one another.

Two passages from the play accompany the exhibition:

*The Silence often of pure innocence
Persuades when speaking fails*

and, in one of Shakespeare's most famously abrupt stage directions:

Exit, pursued by a bear.

Together, they suggest something of the exhibition's range. *A Winter's Tale* is an invitation to look closely, to give small things time, and to remain open to what may emerge when we do.
